Dear Students & Parents:

This class is for students fifteen years old or older at the time the session starts, and is intended primarily for Northfield Public School District residents. Students who will be fifteen years of age by the end of the session, or students who are not residents of the Northfield Public School District, will only be permitted to take the class if it has not filled by the registration deadline. Available openings will then be filled with the oldest applicants. Classes are offered during the year in the fall, winter, spring, early summer and late summer. Complete the registration form below and return it to the Community Services office, along with payment. Registrations are accepted in person, by fax or by mail. Registration is not final until payment is made.

- Fees: *\$150.00 upon registration for the Classroom Phase.
 *\$249.00 upon registration for Behind-the-Wheel training (must have permit).
 *These rates are subject to change.

After successful completion of the classroom training, students will receive a Certificate of Classroom Completion card, referred to as a Blue Card, which is necessary to apply for an Instruction Permit. You may take your permit test at any Minnesota Driver's license exam station. The closest stations are in Faribault and Eagan. Cost for replacement of lost or damaged cards is \$10.00. In addition to the Blue Card, you will need one form of identification from the primary list and one form from the secondary list, detailed in Chapter One of the Driver's Manual. Examples of the most common identification forms are:

- An original birth certificate with a raised seal from the courthouse and a social security card
- An original birth certificate with a raised seal from the courthouse and a passport

You may register for Behind-the-Wheel only after completing the Classroom Phase and obtaining a permit. Registration forms will be handed out during the Classroom Phase of Driver Education and are also available at the Community Services office.
