Human Body Lab – Your student will lead you through an experiment they designed in class. You will be their guinea pig! Examples of human body labs in the past include: How does music affect memory? How does gender affect muscle flexibility? How do distractions affect reaction time? How does caffeine affect pulse? Bring any supplies you need to do the lab!

Poetry Café – In English class, students have learned about various aspects of poetry. They have written poems, learned how to read poems out loud, and studied many types of poems. Visit the Poetry Café to hear student poetry performances. *Students need to sign up for a poetry reading slot in advance.

Math Exploration – In this activity, parents and students are invited to stop in to visit Mr. Meyers or Mrs. Dokken and solve an interesting math problem together for extra credit.

Welcome to Semester 2 of Social Studies – Students have recently switched social studies teachers. Meet Mr. Weinmann or Mrs. Hovden and learn how the second semester of social studies will work.
